

## Paint Colors

---

Allsteel paint finishes are formulated for optimum hardness and chip resistance. All Allsteel paints meet or exceed EPA manufacturing standards for air quality. While Allsteel maintains strict standards of color consistency, shades of color may vary.

### **Painted Metal Surfaces**

General soil on painted metal surfaces may be wiped clean with warm water and mild soap or ammonia-based foam glass cleaner. Please contact your Allsteel Dealer or Allsteel Customer Support for instructions on removing more difficult soil. Allsteel finishes do not scratch or scuff easily, but if damage occurs, retouch with Allsteel color-matched, air-dry enamels. Touch-up paint and retouching instructions may be ordered through your Allsteel Dealer or Allsteel Customer Support.

### **Painted Wood Surfaces**

General soil on painted wood surfaces may be wiped clean with warm water and mild detergent using a clean, soft cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners such as Comet and Soft Scrub, Lysol cleaners, and acetone-based cleaners. For spot cleaning, use Fantastik or 409 and wipe surface dry with a clean, soft cloth. Use Zud to remove metal marring on the surface. Allsteel finishes do not scratch or scuff easily, but if damage occurs, retouch with Allsteel color-matched, air-dry enamels. Touch-up paint and retouching instructions may be ordered through your Allsteel Dealer or Allsteel Customer Support.

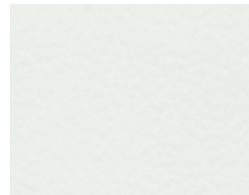
Although the painted metal and painted wood colors reproduced on this card were matched with care, they may vary from the actual finish. When color is critical, please obtain a physical sample.
